



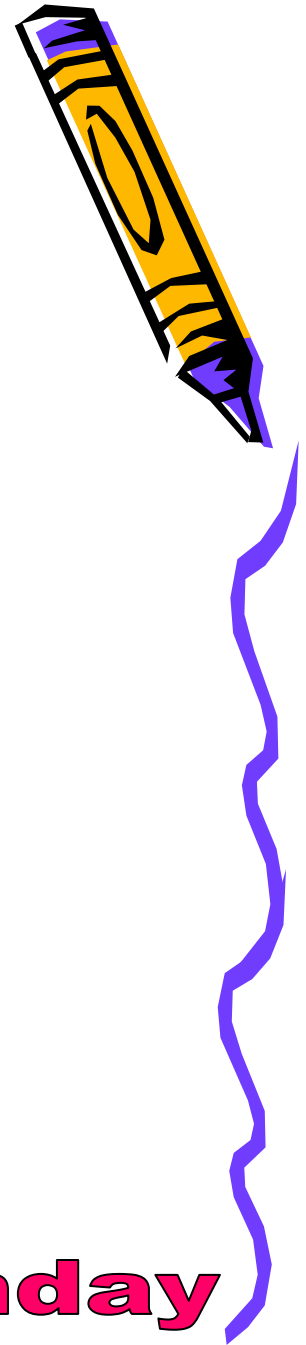

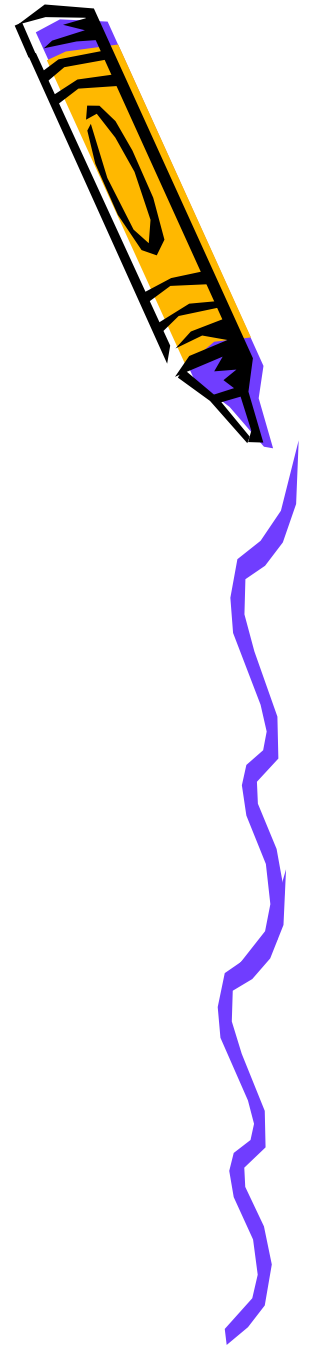


Beginning of the Year Socially

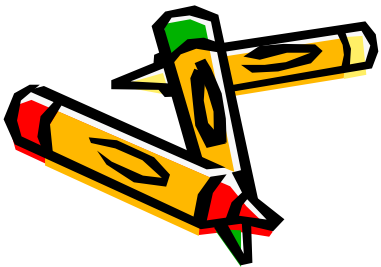

Amy's penmanship has improved tremendously since the beginning of the year. We really focused on the letters of her name first. She loves to write and draw.

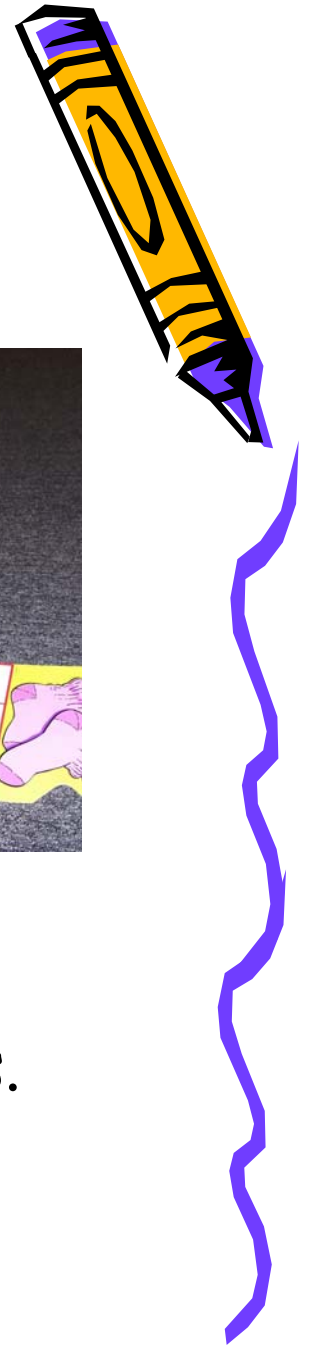
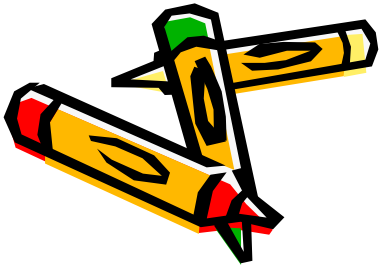

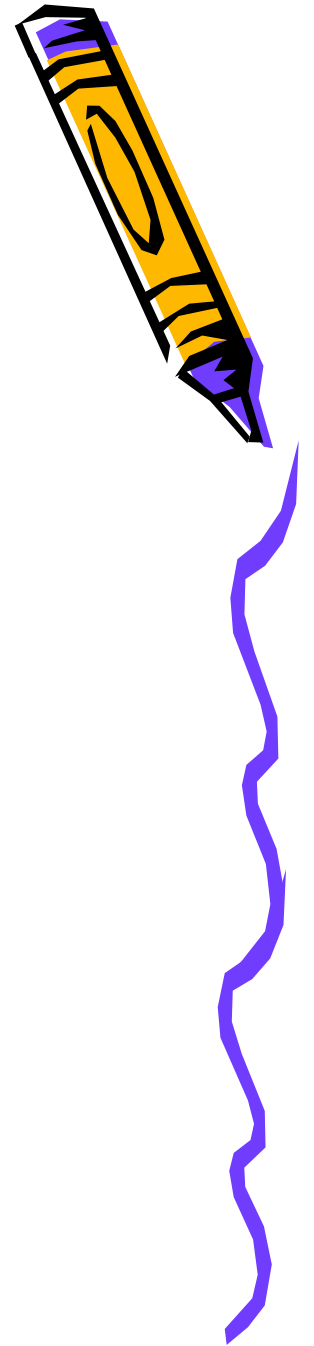


Amy LOVES to Rhyme. She will say a word or discover a new word then come ask me what rhymes with it or she will tell me what rhymes.

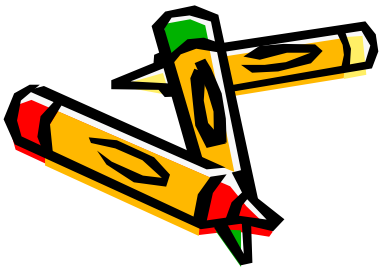

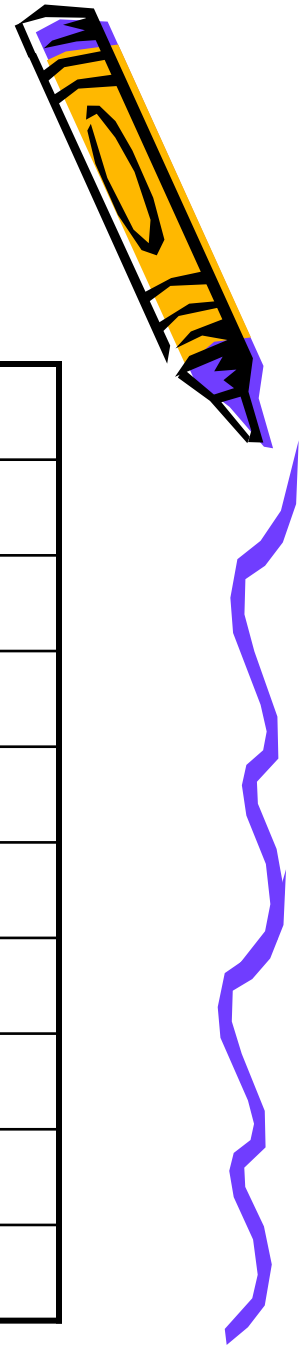


Middle of the Year SOCIALY

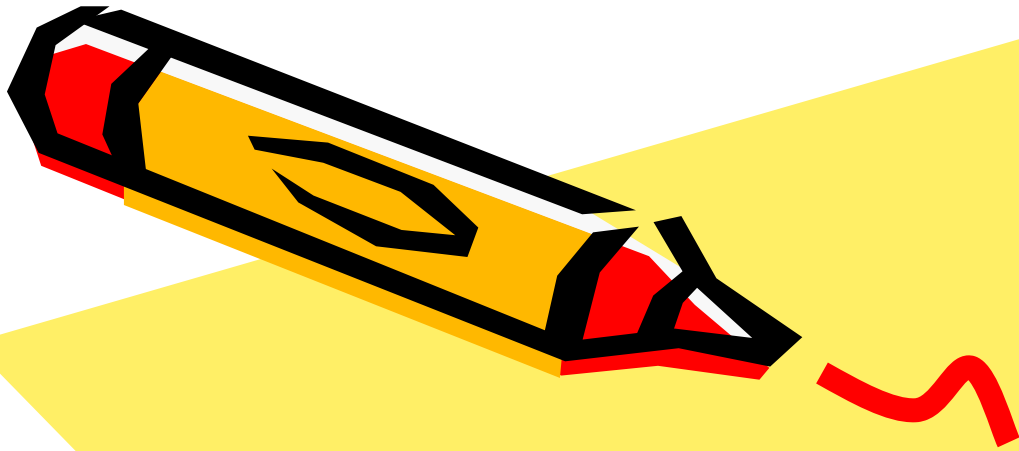

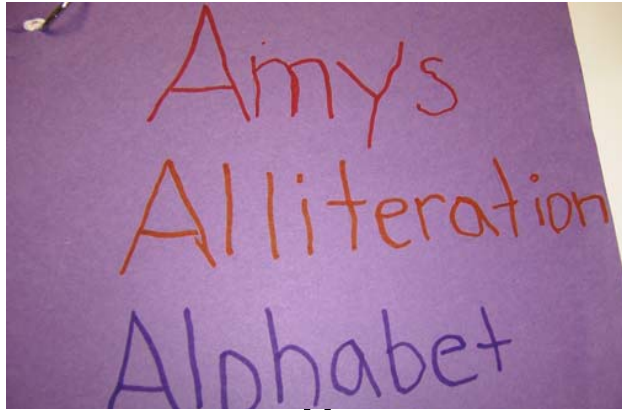




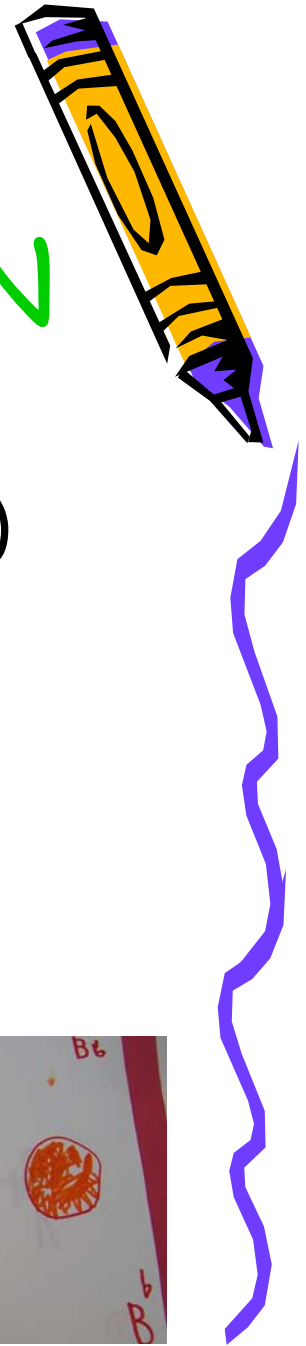
