Transitions



Syllabication, Alliteration, and Graphs

Syllabication: Have students clap the syllables in their names as they go off to centers/line.

Deb /ra – 2 claps

Me/lis/sa – 3 claps

Alliteration: Make up alliterative sentences for students, and ask children if they can remember what their friends do. Make up one or two per day and stress the beginning sounds. For example: **L**eslie likes to **l**ick lollypops., **B**en eats **b**ig burgers., **A**lyssa **a**te an apple.

Graphs: Make and laminate a graph that can be used throughout the year. Use attributes that have to do with the theme you are working on. For example: All About Me Theme:

- Color of eyes
- How many girls and boys
- How old are you
- Color of hair, etc.
- Place the graph in the math center for children to observe.
