If Your Name Starts With A...

Vocabulary: build, tinker, play, measure

Procedure

- Teacher will encourage children to listen for the beginning sounds of “construction” words and pretend to do that action.
- Children will identify the beginning sounds of “construction” words.

Example

If your name starts with a /b/ build with blocks.

If your name starts with a /t/ tinker with the tools.

If your name starts with a /p/ play with paint.

If your name starts with an /m/ measure the mat.

Variation: When you hear a construction word that starts with the same sound as your name, you can line up.

building... Bailey

tools... Terri and Tameka

house... Jose

fence... Frank

paint... Paul

wood... Juan
