Math



How Many Ways to Come to School?

Vocabulary: transportation, car, bus, walk, how many, tallest, shortest, lowest.

Materials

- Poster board
- Paper pictures of choices
- Bar graph

Procedure

- Prepare the graph headings by asking the children ways they come to school. (Create a bar graph using the 4-5 transportation methods as columns).
- Add all the responses to the graph.
- Individually ask the children. "How did you come to school today?"
- Have the children select the picture that represents the way they came to school.
- Then have the children place the picture in the correct place on the graph.
- Say, "Let's look at how we come to school. How many ride in a car? How many ride a bus? How many walk? Oh, look one of you rides a bicycle."
- Also reference which category has more, has less, or has the same amount.
